## Eligibility

In order to qualify, the applicant must be a permanent resident of the City of Kamloops and meet **one or more** of the following criteria:

- Receive Income Assistance from the Ministry of Housing and Social Development.
- Have an annual income in the previous/ current year (depending on when applying) that is below the Statistics Canada Low Income Guidelines. See application for details.
- Receive a Canadian Pension or Long-term Disability that is below the Low Income Guidelines as outlined in the application form.

## How to Apply

**Step 1:**  
Meet the eligibility criteria.

**Step 2:**  
Fill out the application. Applications are available on our website at [www.kamloops.ca/communityprograms/arch](http://www.kamloops.ca/communityprograms/arch) or can be picked up at Tournament Capital Centre (TCC), Westsyde Pool, or Interior Savings Centre.

**Step 3:**  
Take your application to one of the three public screening agencies (White Buffalo, Interior Friendship Centre, or the Family Tree Family Centre) or visit our website to view all of the community agencies that refer clients to the ARCH program.

**Step 4 (Upon Approval):**  
The screening or referral agency will provide you with an information package and a City of Kamloops Activity Guide for you to review before you register.

**Step 5:**  
Register for the ARCH program by bringing the third page of your application (acceptance form) and photo ID to TCC, Westsyde Pool or Interior Savings Centre to register for City of Kamloops recreational programs.
