SPECIAL OCCASION TYPES

Private Special Occasion

A private special occasion includes:

- Social, cultural, recreational, religious, sporting, or community events.
- Celebrations of family occasions such as:
 - weddings, birthdays, wedding anniversaries,
 - christenings, bar mitzvahs, or other religious occasions,
- Tastings to acquaint people with the product of a winery, brewery, or distillery.

Public Special Occasion

A public special occasion is:

- A community or public celebration,
- A tasting, open to the public, intended to acquaint the public with the products of a licensed liquor manufacturer.

Anyone may attend a public special occasion - entry is open to anyone who wishes to participate or buy a ticket (either at the door or in advance of the event). The phrase "community or public celebration" is interpreted very widely and includes a broad range of events which contribute to the cultural/social life of the community.

The RCMP will take into consideration the location, nature, and duration of the proposed special occasion and the proposed quantity of liquor in relation to the number of adults attending the event, and may:

- Support the event;
- Refuse permission for an event to be held; or
- Require restrictions of terms or conditions such as the exclusion of minors or limited hours of liquor service be placed on the Special Occasion Licence (SOL).
