

SIDEWALK CLEARING FOR SENIORS

The City of Kamloops has contributed towards the sidewalk-clearing program for seniors, which is coordinated by SIRRS – the Senior Information, Referral, and Resource Society.

Seniors needing volunteers to clear snow from the sidewalk in front of their home must pre-register and pre-qualify for assistance based on income.

Volunteers are needed in many areas of the city, and the Society strives to match seniors with volunteers in their neighbourhood. This is a great opportunity for families to volunteer together, or anyone who wants to help their neighbour. Children must have permission of their parent or guardian, and in the interest of senior safety, all volunteers must undergo a (free) Police Records Check.
