1. DESCRIPTION OF WORK

1.1 Work shall include, but shall not necessarily be limited to, the following principal items:

1.1.1 Providing, maintaining and subsequently removing Security to protect the Public.

1.1.2 Clearing and Grubbing.

1.1.3 Stripping, salvaging, stockpiling for subsequent re-use and subsequently re-constructing into Restoration Area, selected Topsoil Materials OR Stripping and disposal off site at an approved location of surplus Topsoil Materials. $\pm 25 \text{ m}^3$

1.1.4 Removal and disposal off site, at an approved location, of Unsuitable and Surplus Earthen Materials. $\pm 775 \text{ m}^3$

1.1.5 Supplying and constructing Imported Granular Embankment Materials into embankment. $\pm 200 \text{ m}^3$

1.1.6 Supplying and constructing Imported Filter Blanket Materials into embankment. $\pm 650 \text{ m}^3$

1.1.7 Supplying and constructing Imported Rip-Rap Materials into embankment. $\pm 900 \text{ m}^3$

1.1.8 Supplying and constructing Imported Asphalt Concrete and Granular Materials for any required Roadway Restoration. $\pm 20 \text{ t} \ \& \ 30 \text{ m}^3$

1.1.9 Constructing City Supplied Topsoil Type Materials and Seed into Restoration Area. $\pm 50 \text{ m}^3$

1.1.10 Supplying and constructing Geccel Panels and Straw-Coconut Blanket into Restoration Area. $\pm 125 \text{ m}^2 \ \& \ \pm 100 \text{ m}^2$

1.1.11 Clean up during and upon completion of the Work.

2. SCHEDULE

- 2.1 The work shall be Substantially Completed by 2010-12-11.
- 2.2 The Contractor shall provide a Schedule for the Work with his Quotation.

3. SPECIFICATIONS

- 3.1 The work shall be carried out in accordance with the Specifications titled Section 1075 attached hereto.
